

# Slovenský kostol Sv. Cyrila a Metoda

## Sts. Cyril and Methodius Parish

8. Nedel'a v Cezročnom Období.

8th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

*Iba v Bohu spočinď, duša moja.*

*Rest in God alone, my soul.*

**„Nemôžete slúžiť Bohu i mamone.“** Boh sice stvoril materiálny svet, ale nie preto, aby sa stal našim bohom, aby sme sa na ňom natrvalo usadili. Svet je len prechodným miestom na ceste k Bohu. Beda človeku, ktorý to nepochopí a svet sa pre neho stane konečnou zástavkou. Naozaj, človek môže zapadnúť až po uši do blata tejto zeme. Svet hľása kult mamony, vidielneho a materiálneho bohatstva. Mnoho ľudí mu inštinktívne slúži a to nielen neveriaci, a súčasne používajú praktiky a metódy tohto sveta, smerujú za hodnotami tohto sveta.

Kedy vlastne človek slúži mameone a nie Bohu? Vtedy, keď nás starosť o materiálne dobrá natoľko pohlcuje, že vytláča myšlienku na Boha. Môže ísť len o kúsok pola, pre ktoré sa súdime s vlastným bratom a budeme sa stále v myšlienkach točiť okolo tohto fliačku zeme, neschopní sústrediť sa na Boha. „Pán Ježiš na inom mieste hovorí: „Kde je tvor poklad, tam bude aj tvore srdce!“ To platí tu na zemi, ale táto príťažlivosť trvá aj po smrti. Len dobrovoľne chudobní vojdú do Božieho kráľovstva. Chudoba, ktorú Ježiš požaduje nielen od rehoľníkov, ale od každého kresťana, spočíva v slobode od vecí. Aby sme z lásky k Bohu opustili všetko i samých seba.

Môže sa nám zdáť, že Pán Ježiš propaguje bezstarostný život ľudí žijúcich v džungli, ktorí sa ešte živia zberom plodín a šatia kožušinou ulovených zvierat. Takto to určite Pán Ježiš nemyslel. Nehovorí: „O nič sa nestarajte“ On hovorí: „Nebudťte ustarosteni“ a v tom je podstatný rozdiel. Nestarat' sa o nič, je proti príkazu, ktorý človek dostal už pri svojom stvorení, keď mu bolo povedané, že má obrábať a strážiť raj, že si má podmaniť zem. Sú veci na tejto zemi, ktoré môžeme a máme

urobiť my. Pán Ježiš nás nezbavuje starosti a zodpovednosti o náš svet, ale zbavuje nás ustarostenosti. Ustarostenosť je starostlivosť, ktorá vôbec nepočíta s Bohom a s jeho mocou a ochotou pomôcť. Naša neveriacia ustarostenosť sa prejavuje aj v tom, že sa rodiny boja prijať dieťa a hľadajú možné i nemožné kompromisy. Keď som bol malý, často som obdivoval mojich rodičov, ktorí hoci nás bolo jedenásť, stále mali túto dôveru v Boha, ktorý sa postará. A Pán Boh nás nikdy nesklamal. Neveriacia ustarostenosť robí zo života cosi tăžké a mučivé, lebo sú určité veci, ktoré človek pri najväčšej svojej snahe a práci nemôže ovplyvniť.

Modlitba je miestom, kde môžeme svoje starosti odovzdať Bohu, odovzdať mu svoju roztržitosť, pretože práve ona v sebe nesie všetko to, čo nás morí a na čo nevládzeme. Na Boha máme uvaliť všetky svoje starosti, lebo On sa stará. Kategizmus učí: „Svedectvo písma je jednoznačné: starostlivosť Božej prozretelnosti je konkrétna a bezprostredná: stará sa o všetko od najmenších vecí po najväčšie svetové a dejinné udalosti. Posvätné knihy zdôrazňujú úplnú Božiu zvrchovanosť nad behom udalostí: „Boh nás je na nebesiach, učinil všetko, čo chcel.“ (Ž 115,3)

**While money** seems for many to be the absolute measure of value, idolizing it is for Jesus the greatest enemy of the worthwhile, just and united world God wants. It is twenty centuries since the Prophet of Galilee denounced, in no uncertain terms, the worship of money as the major obstacle holding humanity back from a more humane coexistence. The reasoning of Jesus is clear: "You cannot serve God and money." God cannot reign as the Father

of all, if justice is denied to those who are excluded from a life of dignity. Hence people dominated by the passion to accumulate wealth cannot build the humane world God wants, so long as they promote an economy that condemns the weakest to hunger and misery. The core message of Pope Francis is about righting that deep-rooted wrong. What he says is: "No to an economy of exclusion and iniquity, for that kind of economy kills." While Francis does not offer any detailed economic analysis to explain his thought, he knows how to summarize his indignation in clear and expressive words that could make headlines in any country. Here are just a few of the examples he cites: "How is it possible that the death from cold of an old man on the streets does not make news while the fall of two points of the stock market does? This is a shameful exclusion." "It's intolerable that food is thrown out while there are people who go hungry. That is criminal and wrong!" – though of course it is not illegal, in our coldly capitalist world. We seem to live "in the dictatorship of a faceless economy without a genuinely human purpose." As a result, "while the profits of a few grow exponentially, the majority remain increasingly far from the wellbeing of that happy few."

The cult of personal prosperity and wellbeing can anaesthetize us to the needs of others, and we grow impatient if the market offers something we haven't yet bought, while all too many lives are stunted and cut short for want of resources. As the Pope has said: "this message isn't Marxism but pure Gospel." It's a message that must have a lasting welcome and echo in our Christian communities. What am I doing to help those less fortunate than myself?
