**Dnešné čítanie** z listu sv. apoštola Pavla Rimanom nám odhaľuje podstatu nášho náboženstva. „Bratia, pretože sme ospravednení z viery, skrze nášho Pána Ježiša Krista, žijeme v pokoji s Bohom.“ Cele hlásanie Pána Ježiša stojí na tom istom základe: „Kto uverí a dá sa pokrstiť, bude spasený!“ My by sme sa radi pred Pánom Bohom niečím vykázali. Radi by sme si Spásu zaslúžili, ako niečo, čo by sme mohli nazvať „naš výkon“. Výkon, ktorým by sme sami sebe i Bohu dokazali, že sme niekto, že nie sme nejaké béčka. Chceme sami pred sebou dokázať, že sme lepší ako druhí. Ťažko nám je prijať názor, že spásu potrebujeme tak, ako chorý človek potrebuje operáciu. Spása je Božia operácia nutná k tomu, aby sa môj slušný život stal dobrým životom. Božie Slovo i Učenie Cirkvi nám hovorí, že do Božieho Kráľovstva vstupujeme vierou. A to vierou, akú objavujeme u praotca Abraháma: „Abrahám uveril Bohu a bolo mu to počítané za spravodlivosť.“ Jeho vieru a teda aj našu vieru nesmieme zamieňať so štúdiom a znalosťou teológie. Studovať teológiu v našom katolíckom prostredí môžu len tí nadanejší a po prípade sa vyžaduje morálna bezúhonnosť u uchádzačov, ale veriť ako veril Abrahám môže aj mentálne zaostalý, alebo na smrť odsúdený lotor, ba dokonca prostitútka. Viera Abraháмова to je predovšetkým dôvera v Boha, v dobrotu Boha, v Božie milosrdenstvo. Viera Abraháмова to je koniec urážania Boha ustavičným podozrievaním a zazeraním. Ako malé deti sme dostali do vienkia schopnosť veriť. Táto schopnosť veriť nám umožňuje žiť v tomto svete. Keby sme neverili, ani by sme sa po prvý krát nenadýchli, asi by sme sa neodvážili piť materské mlieko, lebo čo ak je vzduch alebo mlieko otrávené. Na základe

viery funguje život. Telesný život potrebuje prijímanie potravy, vzduchu, tekutín, duševný život zase žije prijímaním informácií, vedomostí a vytváraním vzťahov. Každé prijímanie zasa vyžaduje otvorenosť a to je podstatná vlastnosť viery.

Preto aj viera a odpustenie idú spolu, lebo práve neodpustenie pôsobí uzatvorenie. Toto je viera, ktorou žije každý človek, či je nábožný alebo nenábožný. Toto je viera, bez ktorej sa nedá žiť vo svete. Ako deti sme ňou oplývali. Ako dospievajúci ju postupne strácame vplyvom tohto sveta, o ktorom píše sv. Ján evanjelista, že „svet (človeka) leží v moci Zlého“. Sami to považujeme za znak dospelosti a múdrosti, povieme „že už nie sme naivní“. Zmúdreli sme. Svet nás čomusi naučil. Za najmúdrejšieho v tomto svete sa považuje ten, kto povie: „Ja už neverím nikomu a ničomu.“ Ale my sa nazývame „veriaci“. Sú náboženstva, ktoré stoja na ľudskej skúsenosti a vôbec nevyžadujú vieru. Naše náboženstvo však stojí na Božom Slove. Nie na tom, čo vymysleli ľudia, ale na tom, čo hovorí Boh. Ak sme skutočne veriaci, môžeme podobne povedať, ako povedali Samaritáni v dnešnom evanjeliu žene, ktorá ich priviedla ku Kristovi: „Už neveríme, len pre tvoje slová, ale sami sme počuli a vieme, že toto je skutočne Spasiteľ sveta.“ Veríme pre Božie Slovo. Ak sme uverili v Ježiša Krista, tak sme uverili v Dobrotu nášho Boha, ktorý tak miluje človeka, že dáva svojho jediného Syna pre nás a za nás a v ňom sa dáva sám Otec.

**Many people**, especially lately, find themselves far away from God, without even knowing what is really going on inside of them. By now God ends up 'something strange' to them. Everything connected to God

seems to them to be empty and meaningless: a childish world, fading into the past. I understand them. I know what they might be feeling. I too find myself further and further away from such a «God of my childhood» that used to awaken in me so many fears, grief, unease. Probably without Jesus I never would have met a God who for me today is a Mystery of goodness: a presence that is friendly and welcoming, one whom I can always trust.

The task of proving my faith with scientific evidence has never attracted me: I believe it's mistaken to regard the mystery of God as if it were a laboratory project. But neither have religious dogmas helped me to really meet God. I simply have let myself be led by a confidence in Jesus that has continued growing over the years. I can't explain exactly how my faith sustains me today in a religious crisis that affects me as much as everyone else. I would only say that Jesus has brought me to live a faith in God in a simple way from the depth of my being. If I listen, God isn't silent. If I open myself, God isn't closed. If I entrust myself, God welcomes me. If I give myself, God sustains me. If I fall down, God raises me up.

I believe the first and most important experience is to find a way to enjoy God as a *saving presence*. When a person knows what it is to enjoy God because, in spite of our mediocrity and selfishness, God welcomes us as we are, then it would be difficult to abandon the faith. Many people today are abandoning God without ever having known God. If they knew the experience of God that Jesus spreads, they would be seeking God. If they recognized the *gift* that God is, they wouldn't abandon God. They would find themselves *enjoying* God.
