

5th Sunday of Lent.

U Pána je milosrdstvo a hojné vykúpenie.

With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption.

Udalosti, ktoré v živote prežívame, majú obyčajne dva zmysly. Jeden zmysel je prirodzený, ten, ktorý bezprostredne udalosť vytvára. Avšak Boh vo svojom vykupiteľskom pláne aj zdanivo zlým udalostiam dáva iný zmysel, nadprirodzený. Aj smrťou môže byť oslávený Syn Boží. Boh je oslavnený všetkým tým, čo zjavuje jeho dobrotu a moc. Aj ľudské utrpenie môže byť prieskorm, kde sa môže zjavovať Božia dobrota a slabosť človeka môže byť prieskorm, v ktorom sa zjaví Božia moc.

V príbehu, ktorý vykresľuje dnešné evanjelium, narázame na ľudskú slabosť, ktorá kapituloje pred mocou smrti. V dnešnom Evanjeliu sa nám odhaluje pravda o tom, že život nie je čosi, ale Ktosi. Ježiš je Logos, Božie Slovo, Informácia a zároveň Život. Život je naozaj pôvodu mimozemského, dokonca môžeme povedať nadprirodzeného. Život je Ktosi väčší ako my. My zjeme, máme účasť na živote, sme živý ale nie sме Život. Život je kvalitou Boha. Ježiš sa však nezjavuje len ako Život, ale aj ako Vzkriesenie. Vzkriesenie je radikálna obnova všetkého, čo hriech zahubil, či už ide o potratenej deti, alebo vyhynuté prírodné druhy. Ježiš povedal: „Odváťte kameň!“ Odvalte kameň vašej malej viery a dufajte v Syna Božieho, ktorý robí veľké veci. Človek sa bojí svojej viery. Marta, sestra mŕtveho, mu povedala: „Pane, už páchnie, ved' je už štyri dni mŕtvych.“ Ježiš jej povedal: „Nehovoril som ti, že ak uveríš, uvidíš Božiu slávu?“ Viera nás vždy vedie k vidaniu Bozej Slávy. Božiu Slávu sme dokonca schopní vidieť tam, kde ľudské oko môže zachytiť už len rozklad a unikajúci život.

Viera a modlitba vďaka robí veľký zázrak. Ježiš sa modlí: „Otče, d'ákujem ti, že si ma vypočul. A ja som vedel, že ma

vždy počuješ, ale povedal som to pre zástup, čo tu stojí, aby uveril, že si ma Ty posiel.“ A keď to povedal, zvolal mocným hlasom: „„Lázár, pod' von!“ Človek nikdy nie je natol'ko mŕtvy, žeby nepočul na svoje meno, keď ho volá Boh. A mŕtvy vyšiel. Nohy a ruky mal ovinuté plachtami a tvár obviazanú šatkom. Ježiš im povedala: „Porozvážujte ho a nechajte ho odísť!“ V Ježišovej dobe mala táto výzva svoje opodstatnenie. Život v osobe Pána Ježiša bol prítomný na tomto svete medzi ľuďmi.

Dnes je Ježiš v nebeskej sláve. A táto výzva dostáva skôr iný zmysel. Rozviažme mŕtveho! Nezväzujme ho svojimi citmi, nechajme ho odísť, nechajme ho ísť za Ježišom. To je snáď ta najväčšia služba lásky, ktorú môžeme preukázať mŕtviemu. Povzbudit' jeho vieri: „Pán je tu, volá 'ta!“ Preukázať mu veľkodušnosť a prepustiť ho na slobodu. Uvoľniť putá svojich citov a plný vďačnosti prepustiť zosnulého na Slobodu. Tešme sa spolu sním, že už je tam, kde život nekončí. Kde žiť znamená Kristus a kde smrť je pre neho ziskom!

Jesus never hides his tenderness towards the two sisters and their brother who live in Bethany. Surely they are the ones who welcome him in their home whenever he goes up to Jerusalem. One day Jesus receives the message: «Our brother Lazarus, your friend, is sick». Shortly afterwards, Jesus heads out for their small village.

When he gets there, Lazarus has already died. When Mary, the younger sister, sees him there, she breaks down crying. No one can console her. When Jesus sees his friend crying, along with the Jews who are with her, he can't contain himself. He too «breaks down and cries» right along with them.

The people remark: «See how much he loved him!». Jesus doesn't just cry for the death of a very beloved friend. His soul is broken when he feels the powerlessness of all in the face of death.

All of us carry in our deepest heart an insatiable will to live. How often we wonder, why do we have to die? Why isn't life happier, longer, more secure, more fulfilled? Today too, like people of every age, we feel in our hearts that unsettling question, one that's hardest to answer: what's going to happen to us when we die? What can we do in the face of death? Fight it? Give up?

Without doubt, the most usual reaction is to just forget that question and «get on with living». But isn't the human person called to live life lucidly and responsibly? When the end finally comes, do we end up just approaching it stoically, not knowing where we stand? In face of the mystery of our final destiny neither scientific nor religious dogmas are of much help. They can't lead us beyond this life. We Christians don't really know any more about the next life than anyone else. Like all others, we need to approach humbly the dark fact of our death. But we do it trusting radically in the goodness of the mystery of God, that is shown to us in Jesus. This Jesus is the one whom we love, without having seen him, and whom in that love, we profoundly trust.

This trust can only be lived by one who responds with simple faith to what Jesus says: «I am the resurrection and the life. Do you believe this?». Recently Hans Kung, the most critical Catholic theologian of the 20th century, coming toward the end of his life, said that for him, dying is «resting in the mystery of God's mercy». That's how I want to die.
