15. Nedela v Cezročnom Období.

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Pane, navštív našu zem a požehnaj jej rastliny.

The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest.

Dnes v prvom čítaní a v evanjeliu sme počuli niečo, čo môže každý z nás pozorovať a porovnať vo vlastnej záhrade alebo v okolitej prírode. Celá príroda doslova túžobne očakáva zjavenie sa Božích Synov a to sa má udiť skrue nás, ktorí prijímame a žijeme Božie Slovo. Možno si kladieme otázku: „Ak je toto všetko Pravda, prečo nachádzame tak málo účinkov v sebe i okolo seba?“ V dnešnom podobenstve o rozsievacomu nám Pán Ježiš dáva odpoveď na túto otázku. Vzhladom na vztah ľudí ku slovu Božiemu nás rozdeluje Ježiš do štyroch kategórií.

1. Ľudia nechápajúci. Toto je človek, u ktorého bolo zrno zasiaté na kraj cesty.“ Je logické, že to, čo človek nepochopil, obyčajne ani nedokáže prijať a zapamätať si. Pri počúvaní Božieho Slova potrebujeme zvláštnu Božiu pomoc, Svetlo Ducha Svätého. Bez osobného prijatia Ježiša, bez priateľstva s Bohom, teda bez Božej milosti, nie sme schopní preniknúť do hĺbky Božieho Slova. Ak chceme mať ozajstný úžitok zo štúdia Písma Svätého, mali by sme ho podobne ako Božie Telo, prijímať v stave Posväčujúcej milosti. Diabol striedne na Božie Slovo, ako tie vtáky na zrno padnuté na kraj cesty.

2. Ľudia nestali. Sú to ľudia, ktorí „vypočujú Slovo a hned' ho s radostou prijímajú; avšak nemajú v sebe koreň, sú nestali“. Mohli by sme povedať, že im chýba hľbka. Ked' príde súženie a prenasledovanie pre Slovo, ihned' odpadnú. Sú to ľudia bez hľbky duchovného života, ľudia povrchní, často nadšení ale len kdesi na povrchu. Koreňom duchovného života je spojenie s Bohom, teda modlitba. Teda ľudia nestali práve kvôli tomu, že sa nemodlia, lebo sa neživia z Boha. Ak sami v sebe objavujeme túto „nezakorenenosť“, dostávame

účinný liek modlitbu. Stále sa snažme o spojenie s Bohom vo svojich myšlienkach, slovách i skutkoch a potom prinesieme úrodu.

3. Ľudia obtiažení starosťami o tento svet. U nich je Slovo zasiate do trnía. Síce „vypočujú Slovo, ale starost tohto sveta a vábivé bohatstvo udusia v nich Slovo, ktoré neprinesie úrodu“. Svet, v ktorom žijeme, je miestom boja. Všetko, čo nás zdržuje na ceste k Bohu, sa stáva zlom. V tomto zmysle aj „dobré veci“ sa môžu stať problémom, pretože sme vyzvaní opúšťať dobré veci kvôli Lepšiemu. Ježiš nazýva trním to, čo je často najväčšou starosťou nás ľudí: „materiálny blahobyt“. Mnoho ľudí si okolo seba až namáhavo buduje tento záhon trnía. Odmena za našu starosť, udusené Slovo. Aj proti tejto chorobe existuje liek a to dobrovoľná chudoba v zmysle evanjelia. Teda dobrovoľne prijaté sebaobmedzenie v záujme sebazachovania. Dobrovoľne prijatý kríž je ako opora pri fazuli. Tam, kde ju človek zabodne vyrastie ponad trnie.

4. Ľudia, ktorí počúvajú, chápu a aj uskutočňujú to Slovo. Uplne prvé prikádzanie zo všetkých je hebrejské slovo „Sema!“, ktoré tvorí začiatok hlavného prikádzania lásky k Bohu: „Počuvaj Izrael“. Počúvať, rozmyšľať, chápať a uskutočniť. „A zrno zasiaté do dobré zeme je ten, čo vypočuje Slovo a pochopí ho: toto prinesie úrodu“.

When Jesus concludes the parable of the sower, he makes this invitation: «Anyone who has ears should listen». He asks us to pay attention to the parable. The first statement in the story is: «A sower went out to sow». He does so with a surprising confidence and sows abundantly. The seed falls all over the place, including where it seems impossible for it to germinate.

That's how the farmers of Galilee did it: they sowed even on the sides of the paths and in rocky places. It's not hard to identify who the sower is. That's how Jesus sowed his message. They saw him go out every morning to announce the Good News of God. He sowed his Word among the simple people who welcomed it, and also among the Scribes and Pharisees who rejected it. He never got tired. His sowing won't be fruitless.

Overcome by a strong religious crisis, we can think that Jesus' Gospel has lost its original force and that his message no longer has power to attract the attention of men and women today. Certainly this is not a time to harvest resounding successes, but it is the moment to learn to sow without getting discouraged, with more humility and truth. It's not the Gospel that has lost its humanizing power, but ourselves who are announcing it with a weak and wavering faith. It's not Jesus that has lost his power to attract. We are the ones who have distorted him with our senselessness and contradictions.

Pope Francis has said that when a Christian doesn't live close to Jesus, «he quickly loses enthusiasm and stops being sure of what he is transmitting, he lacks power and passion. And a person who isn't convinced, enthusiastic, sure, in love, doesn't convince anyone». Evangelizing isn't propagating a doctrine, but making the humanizing and saving power of Jesus present in the midst of society and in people's hearts. What's most decisive isn't the number of preachers or teachers of religion, but the evangelical quality that Christians radiate. What are we spreading? Indifference or convinced faith? Mediocrity or a passion for a fuller, more human life?
