16. Nedela v Cezročnom Období.

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

*Ty, Pane, si veľmi dobrý a láskavý
Lord, you are good and forgiving.*

Pán Ježiš nám podoberstvom „O rozsievačovi“ chce dať odpoveď na jednu základnú otázku: Odkiaľ sa vo svete zobral zlo? Je to otázka, ktorá zaujíma každého človeka, veriaceho i neveriaceho. Každý sa so zlom stretá. Zlo nás mätie a zraňuje. Cítime, že sme určení pre dobro. Dobro je pre nás normálne a samozrejme. Na dobro sme nastavení, po dobre túžime. Viera, ktorú Boh od nás očakáva, predpokladá dobro. Dobro viedie k viere. Boh je nekonečne Dobro a všetky jeho diela sú dobré. A predsa sa nikto z nás nevyhne skúsenosti s utrpením, so zlom v sebe i v prírode. Odkiaľ sa tu vzalo zlo? Do úžasného Božieho diela Stvorenia sa vlúdil hriech. Vzburá stvorených bytosť. Boh všetky duchovné bytosť obdaroval darom slobody, lebo ich stvoril pre lásku. O lásku sa nedá hovoriť tam, kde nie je možnosť slobodnej voľby. Pán Boh by nás mohol naprogramovať podľa svojej vôle. Ale vtedy by sa nedalo hovoriť o láске. Láska existuje len tam, kde sa jedna osoba slobodne odovzdáva druhej. Sloboda je rizikom, ale zároveň nutným predpokladom lásky. Táto možnosť slobodnej voľby viedla prvé stvorené bytosť ku vzbure. Ako sa z dobrej bytosť môže stať bytosť zlá. Absolútne nestvorené Dobro, ktorým je Boh, sa nikdy nemôže zvrhnúť na zlo. Ale dobrota ostatných, teda stvorených bytosť, je dobro darovaná a v každom momente závislá od Boha. Akonáhle sa stvorenie uzatvára pred Bohom, stráca svoju dobrotu. Satan a jeho anjeli si podrezali životodárnú tepnu, ktorou je poslušnosť Bohu a jeho Slovu. Stratili kontakt s Pravdou, Láskou, Životom i Krásou. Prečo Boh nestvoril svet taký dokonalý, že by v ňom nemohlo jestvovať nijaké zlo? Vo svojej

nekonečnej moci by Boh mohol vždy stvoriť niečo lepšie. Ale vo svojej nekonečnej múdrosti a dobre chcel Boh slobodne stvoriť svet, ktorý je „na ceste“ k svojej dokonalosti. Anjeli a ľudia, rozumné a slobodné stvorenia, musia kráčať k svojmu poslednému určeniu skrze slobodnú voľbu a hlavné lásku. Teda môžu pohlúdiť. A skutočne, zhrešili. Takto vstúpilo do sveta mravné zlo, nepovratneľne ľahšie ako fyzické zlo. Boh nie je v žiadnom prípade príčinou mravného zla. Ak ho dovoľuje, tak len preto, že rešpektuje slobodu svojho stvorenia a tajomným spôsobom dokáže z neho vývodiť dobro: Lebo všemohúci Boh, keďže je nanajvýš dobrý, by nikdy nedovolil, aby v Jeho dielach jestvovalo akékoľvek zlo, keby nebolo dosť silný a dobrý, žeby zo samotného zla nepovstalo dobro. Takto, časom, môžeme objavíť, že Boh vo svojej všemohúcej prorietelnosti, môže spôsobiť dobro aj z následkov zla. Ved z najväčšieho mravného zla, akého sa človek vôbec dopustil, z vraždy Božieho Syna, Boh svojou prekypujúcou milosťou, vydal najväčšie dobro: oslávenie Krista a naše Vykúpenie. Zlo sa premenilo na ešte väčšie dobro.

Through the centuries, Christianity has been much damaged because of triumphalism, the thirst for power, and the eagerness to impose oneself on our enemies. There are still Christians who yearn for a powerful Church that fills church buildings, conquers the streets and imposes our faith on the whole of society.

We need to go back to two small parables where Jesus makes clear that his followers' task isn't to construct a powerful religion, but rather to put themselves at the service of the Father's humanizing project (God's

Reign), sowing small «seeds» of the Gospel, and mixing themselves into society as a bit of «leaven» in human life.

The first speaks of a mustard seed that is sown in a garden. What's special about this mustard? That it is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it grows, it becomes a bush bigger than the other vegetables. The Father's project has some very humble beginnings, but its transforming force can't be imagined even now.

Jesus' activity in Galilee of sowing deeds of goodness and justice isn't anything grandiose and spectacular: neither in Rome nor in the Jerusalem Temple are they aware of what's happening. The work that his followers are doing today is insignificant: the power centers ignore it. Even we Christians can think that it's useless to work for a better world. Human beings keep on committing the same horrors over and over again, seemingly forever, and we are incapable of catching on to the slow growing of God's Reign.

The second parable speaks of a woman who mixes a little leaven into a large mass of flour. Without anyone knowing how, the leaven goes about working silently until the whole mass is fermented.

That's what happens with God's humanizing project. Once it is introduced into the world, it goes about quietly transforming human history. God doesn't act by imposing Self from outside. God humanizes the world by attracting the consciences of God's children to a more worthy life, one that is more just and fraternal.

God's Reign is always something humble and small in its beginnings, but God is still working among us, promoting solidarity, the desire, justice and a happier world. We need to collaborate with God by following Jesus.
