**Oslavujme Pána, lebo je dobrý, lebo jeho milosrdenstvo trvá naveky.
Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, his love is everlasting.**

Každý rozumný človek od života niečo očakáva. Niektoré očakávania majú ľudia spoločné, iné rozdielne, v závislosti od rozličných životných okolností. Iné od života očakávajú mladí, iné starí ľudia. Iné zdraví, iné chorí. Iné bohatí, iné chudobnejší. Život však prináša aj čosi, po čom nikto netúži — rozličné rany.

S ranami na svojom oslávenom tele sa po zmŕtvychvstani zjavuje aj Ježiš. A práve dotyk a pohľad na Ježišove rany si dal ako podmienku apoštól Tomáš, aby uveril v jeho zmŕtvychvstanie. Bola to zaujímavá podmienka. Skôr by sme očakávali, že povie: „Chcem ho objať.“ Alebo: Chcem ho na vlastné oči vidieť pri stolovaní.“ Prečo práve dotknúť sa jeho rán? Ak sa myšlienkami vrátíme na Kalváriu, pochopíme Tomášovo požiadavku. Nedá sa predsa uveriť, aby človek, ktorému spôsobili toľko rán, mohol ešte žiť. Klincami prepichnuté ruky a nohy, kopijou prebodenuté srdce nemôžu spôsobiť nič iné, iba smrť. A zrazu apoštoli Tomášovi oznamia, že tento doráhaný Ježiš žije. Ako mohol uveriť takejto správe? A preto sa chce dotknúť jeho rán a vložiť ruku do jeho boku, aby mal istotu, že je to pravda.

Ježiš mal porozumenie pre Tomášovu podmienku. Dovoľuje mu, aby sa dotkol jeho rán a zbavil sa pochybností. Tomášovi nič iné neostávalo, iba zvolat: „Pán môj a Boh môj!“ V tej chvíli nielen uveril, že Ježiš žije, ale aj spoznal, že život je mocnejší ako smrteľné rany.

Neexistuje život bez rán. Ak si spomenieme na hociktorú oblasť života, musíme povedať, že každá spôsobuje rany. Manželské či rodinné súžitie. Nádeje vkladané do detí. Pracovné neúspechy. Zrada priateľov... Žijeme a sme zdraví, no zrazu prichádza osudový úder: choroba, nešťastie, smrť

najbližších. Znova pocitujeme rany a krvácame. Keby nám niekto pri kolíske povedal, čo nás v živote stretne, možno by sme ani nechceli žiť. Azda by sme si povedali, že sa to nedá prežiť. A predsa sme to prežili. A možno aj teraz zjedeme s nejakou ranou na tele alebo na duši. Bolí nás to, ale zjedeme — preto, lebo život je mocnejší ako naše rany. Tomáš uveril, lebo sa dotkol Ježišových rán. Aj naše rany sa môžu stať pre iných cestou k viere. Chce to od nás iba jedno: ukázať trpiacim, že sa dá žiť aj s ranami. Je to jedno z najcennejších svedectiev nášho života a viery.

Pravoslávny starec Izidor učil svoje duchovné deti modlitbu k piatim ranám Spasiteľovým: Polož ruku na čelo a povedz: Pane, trňovým vencom na hlave do krvi a mozgu korunovaný pre moje hriechy; polož ruku dole na pravú nohu a povedz: Ježišu, na pravej nohe pribitý železným klincom pre moje hriechy; na pravé plece a povedz: Synu, na pravé plece pribitý železným klincom pre moje hriechy; prenes ruku na l'ave plece a povedz: Boží, aj na l'avej ruke pribitý pre moje hriechy; i na rebrach kopijou prebodenutý z hrude prelievajúci krv a vodu na vykúpenie a spasenie našich duší; skrze Bohorodičku osvet' môj rozum! Obráť sa tvárou k ikone Matky Božej a povedz: A Tebe samej meč prenikne dušu, aby sa v mnohých srdciach otvoril prameň kajúcnych a vďačných úprimných slz celého ľudstva.

The figure of Thomas as the disciple who refuses to believe has been very popular among Christians. The Gospel account, however, says much more about this skeptical disciple. The Risen Jesus addresses him with some words that are associated with an urgent call, and with a loving

invitation, too: *Do not be unbeliefing, but believe.* Thomas, who has refused to believe for a week, responds to Jesus with the most solemn confession of faith that we could ever read in the Gospels: *My Lord and my God.*

What has this disciple experienced in the Risen Jesus? What is it that has transformed this man, doubting and hesitant until then? What inner journey has brought him from skepticism to trust? What is surprising is that, according to the account, Thomas gives up on touching Jesus' wounds in order to verify the truth of the resurrection. What opens him to faith is Jesus himself with his invitation.

All of us have changed much inside over the years. We have become more skeptical, but also more fragile. We have become more critical, but also more insecure. Each one of us has to decide how we want to live and how we want to die. Each one of us has to respond to that call which, sooner or later, whether unexpected or whether a fruit of an inner process, comes to us from Jesus: *Do not be unbeliefing, but believe.*

Maybe we need to awaken more our desire for truth, to develop that inner sensibility we all have to perceive the presence of the Mystery that sustains our lives, beyond the visible and tangible. It is no longer possible for us to live as people who know everything. It is not true. All of us, believers and nonbelievers, atheists and agnostics, walk through life enveloped in darkness. As Paul of Tarsus says, we seek God *groping for him.*

More than one believer today feels that faith has become something increasingly unreal and unsubstantiated. Maybe now that we can no longer find support for our faith, we are learning to seek God with a more humble and sincere heart.
